RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER OF CLAIMS & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

Notice, by signing this document you may be waiving certain legal rights, including the right to sue. Release and Waiver of Claims; Assumption of the Risk; Indemnification Agreement In consideration of being allowed to use the facilities and participate in any event held at the Tioga County Fair, Tioga County Agricultural Society (the "Host").

The Participant hereby agree, to the fullest extent permitted by law, as follows:

- 1) **WAIVE ALL CLAIMS**, demands, and/or causes of action that they have or may have against the Host arising out of the Participant's participation in the Activities or the use of any equipment provided by the Host Equipment and operators, including while receiving instruction and/or training.
- 2) **TO ASSUME ALL RISKS** of participating in the Activities and using the Equipment, even those caused by the negligent acts or conduct of the Host, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers. The Participant and his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s) understand that there are inherent risks of participating in the Activities and using the Equipment, which may be both foreseen and unforeseen and include serious physical injury, paralysis, and death.
- 3) **TO RELEASE** the Host, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and officers from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or his/her next of kin) may suffer, arising out of his/her participation in the Activities and/or use of the Equipment, including while receiving instruction, training, and/or emergency medical care (see Consent to Treat below). The Participant and his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s) specifically understand that they are releasing any and all claims that arise or may arise from any negligent acts or conduct of the Host, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers, to the fullest extent permitted by law. However, nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as a release for conduct that is found to constitute gross negligence or intentional conduct.
- 4) **TO INDEMNIFY** the Host, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers, from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or his/her next of kin) may suffer, arising out of participation in the Activities and/or use of the Equipment, including while receiving instruction, training and/or emergency medical care.

Photography Release Participant hereby grants to the Host, its representatives, and employees the right to take photographs of Participant in connection with Participant's participation in the Activities, regardless of payment by Participant. Participant hereby authorizes the Host to edit, alter, copy, copyright, use, and publish the same in print and/or electronically. Participant hereby agrees that the Host may use such photographs of Participant for any lawful purpose, including but not limited to publicity, illustration,

advertising, Web content, and for purposes of identification for entry into the park.

Consent to Treat Participant hereby consent to any reasonably necessary and appropriate emergency medical treatment provided by the Host, emergency medical responders, and/or other emergency or medical personnel.

Personal Responsibility

The Participant certifies that the Participant has no physical, mental condition that precludes Participant from participating in the Activities and that he/she is not participating against medical advice.

The participant will not participate in any event under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

The Participant's participation in the Activities is voluntary and further understand that they have the opportunity to inspect the Host's Equipment and facilities before any participation.

The Participant understands that Participant is to follow the rules of the Activities and that he/she can minimize his/her risk of injury by doing so and through the exercise of common sense and by being aware of his/her surroundings. If, while participating in the Activities, the Participant observes any unusual hazard or condition, which they believe jeopardizes Participant's personal safety or that of others,

Participants will remove themselves from participation in the Activities and immediately bring said hazard or condition to the attention of the Host. To the extent that any portion of this Agreement is deemed to be invalid under the law of New York, the remaining portions of the Agreement shall remain binding and available for use by the Host, its counsel, and Participant in any proceeding.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I MAY BE WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE.

Safety is paramount.

Failure to comply with all safety requirements will result in disqualification and removal from Fairgrounds.

- A Waiver of Liability is Required upon Registration.

Rules for all Classes:

- Tractors may hook more than once, but not in same weight class.
 - Puller will identify the weight class they belong in.
 - Puller must sign up for the correct class; No class jumping.
- 1st tractor is test puller.
- **We may use a speed limit of 8 MPH Wish is to keep the stock class stock.**
- The Officials decisions are final.
 - Arguments with the Officials can result in dismissal from the Fairgrounds.

Drivers:

- 1 Driver per tractor per class. No Exceptions.

Stock Rules:

- Tractors must be stock in appearance.
 - No Alterations.
 - All OEM
- One (1) Driver per tractor per class. No Exceptions.
- No leeway on weight will be given in any class.

Tractors:

- Tractors must have working hydraulics and/ or PTO.
- No cut or altered tires.
- No Dual Wheels.
- No leeway on weight will be given in any class.

Fuels:

- No alcohol, gasohol or other exotic fuels will be permitted.
- Propane cannot be utilized.
- Diesel tractors must run on diesel only.
 - No Excessive Smoke; Excessive smoke coming from any tractor may be cause for disqualification.
- The 75' Rule will apply except in the event of a pull off in stock class.
 - In a pull off, the 75' rule does not apply.
- Water Injection is not permitted.

Hitches:

- No supports are permitted on a hitch.
- 3-point hitches will not be allowed
- Hitch may only pull straight out from the tractor in the stock location.
- The hitch must be able to hook with official on the sled.
- The maximum hitch of 21" to the top of the bar (not clevis).
- The hitch point must be 3 ¾" from front to back and 3" from side to side

STOCK CLASS (Out-of-Field)


This class is for tractors that are field-ready and largely unmodified.

PERMITTED:

- Factory-stock engine, fuel system, and exhaust
- Working **hydraulics and/or PTO** (must be functional)
- Stock drawbar
- Standard agricultural tires (no cuts or modifications)
- Factory weight brackets and front weights
- Safety enhancements (e.g., roll bar, kill switch, wheelie bars)

NOT PERMITTED:

- **Excessive smoke**—tractors producing excess smoke may be disqualified
- **Turbo or pump enhancements beyond factory settings**

 **Just because a tractor is used in the field doesn't make it Stock Class.** If it sounds hopped up, pulls faster, or visibly outpaces stock peers, it belongs in the Altered Class.

ALTERED / MODIFIED CLASS


For tractors with performance modifications or enhanced pulling features.

PERMITTED:

- Fuel system or engine enhancements (within fuel and smoke rules)
- Pulling-style drawbars
- Relocated or custom weight brackets
- Cosmetic or non-stock parts
- RPM changes (within safe mechanical limits)
- Diesel or gasoline fuel only

NOT PERMITTED:

- Excessive smoke **Excessive smoke**—tractors producing excess smoke may be disqualified

 If your tractor is **tuned, tweaked, or otherwise modified** to pull better than factory spec, this is your class.
